**decaBDE UE DIRECTIVE**

**Confirmation on decaBDE directive:**

GREMCO can confirm that the GREMCO products all comply with the

**EU Directive 2002/95/EC** restriction of the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment ("RoHS directive")

On 1<sup>st</sup> July 2008 the European Court of Justice withdrew the concession ruling within the RoHS directive #9.a "Deca-BDE in polymers". Since that date the use of Deca-BDE is no longer allowed.

**EU Directive 2002/96/EC** waste electrical and electronic equipment ("WEEE directive")  
**EU Directive 2003/11/EC** restrictions on marketing and use of certain dangerous substances.

In accordance with the EU directives GREMCO does not use any of the banned critical substances mentioned in these directives.
